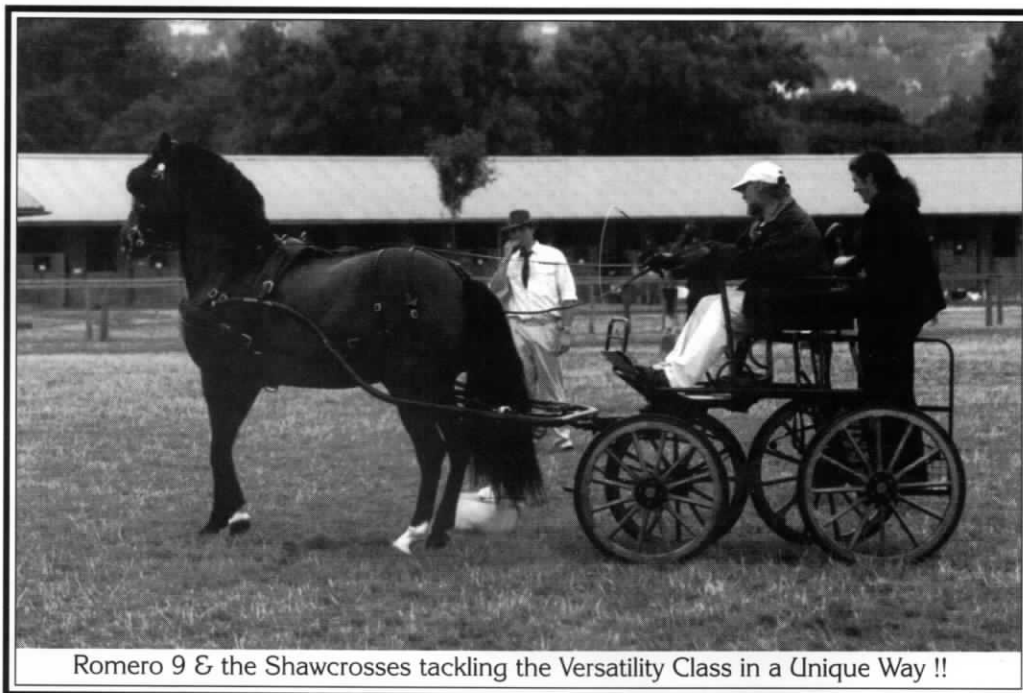

For those Members who are debating about whether they should put their PRE forward for Grading next year here are the **List Of Physical Measurements** that the Grading Commission will be looking for. They are all in meters and centimeters. The Height at the Withers and the Cannon Bone Circumference are MINIMUMS, ie if your horse does NOT reach these Minimums it will not be Approved for Reproduction - it will not pass.

Stud NEWS

Well it has been a busy summer here in Holland, first the settling inperiod, then foaling and then overing. It must be said all the horses have adapted beautifully, adjusting to the ups and downs in the weather. I believe our summer has been a little better than yours. The foal continues to thrive and it remains, at least for now, bay.

The Stallions have been kept busy. Candela and Buscada are in foal to Lebrijano, Gavilana to D.J. and our new mare, Galana VI to a gorgeous black stallion from the Netherlands called Fauno II, a very typey 15.3h Spanish horse. Galana was bred in Sevilla by the well known breeder Antonio Garcia Aguilar, she is by Rondeno VI (Bohorquez) out of Iliada. She is grey, 16.2hh and 5 years old. Her first foal Negrito is black so we wait with baited breath.

Last weekend was our breed show here in the Netherlands as well as inspections and gradings etc. It was amazing to see over 20 foals for inscriptions as well as 8 gradings It is hard to imagine that this society was only formed 6 years ago.

We are so lucky to have our gradings peromed privately in the U.K because in the Netherlands each horse is displayed in front of the spectators with a FULL running commentary. Great if you passed! Pass our fail, scores and comments from the Cria are announced to the audience..

The general quality of the horses is very good with some gorgeous youngsters. There are some interesting bloodlines here and hopefully we can make the most of them during our stay here.

After the entertainment of the gradings it was on to the breed show proper.

Galesa our homebred foal by Lebrijano out of Danes Bienvenida come 3rd in the foal class. Lebrijano came 2nd in the saddle competition

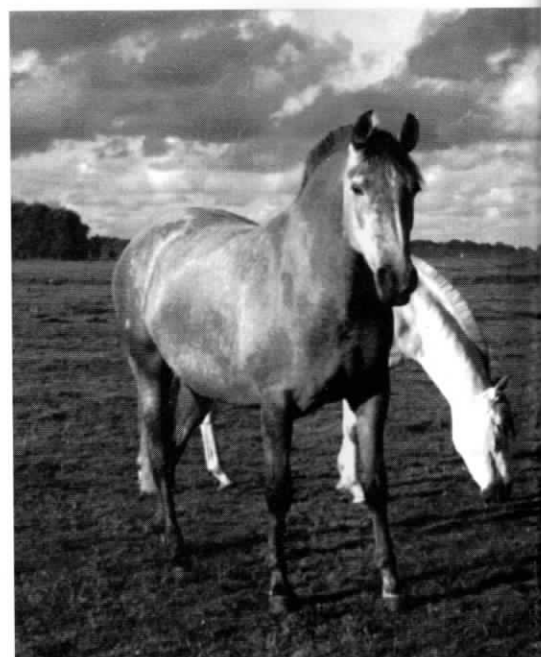
The male champion and ridden champion of N.L was Bolero XL breeder Ignacio Bravo.

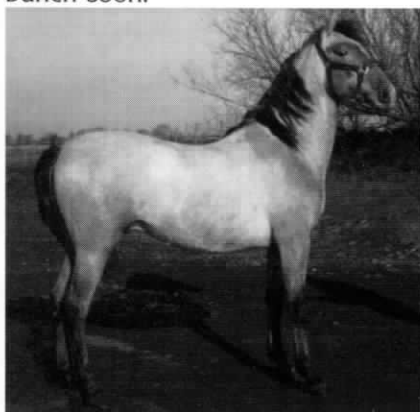
magazine. We all like to hear about your horses & you should be proud to tell everyone about them.

Maryss PRE Stud Wiltshire

Well it has been another very busy year here, with a lot of my time taken up with BAPSH work eg. organising and running the Grading and Inscription days in late June, followed by organising the National Breed Show in early August, plus producing this magazine quarterly too. In between all this I have been finding some time to look after my horses.

Despite all my hopes for Anisada to produce a filly, she did of course produce a colt - number five in a row! However he is an absolute cracker of a colt and a most unusual shade of reddish/goldenish dark bay with a black head and a bright ginger nose. I've named him Maryss KION which

means 'Ginger' in south American Spanish. At the moment I'm planning to run on Maryss Kion and his half-brother Maryss Kemazon to see how they develop.

Argentino has had two other 'products' born this year - a purebred filly foal (grey) to Tina Barnett-Tucker's mare Biosa, and a partbred filly (bay) to a lovely TB mare Fearless Faerie by Ben Faerie. This little sweetie is destined for a serious competition career in either dressage or eventing.

We've got the same mix of 3 purebreds and one partbred in foal to Argentino for next year. Two of the PREs are my own, and then the Disney's young mare, Serenada, is now expecting her first foal (by Argentino) and Maria Ward-Jones partbred filly 'Astra' (by Maryss Brujo) is also in foal to Argentino.

Maryss Dulcinea was sold in April to Judy Garnett, N Yorkshire and is now happily being ridden out through all that lovely scenery.

Maryss Gloria was sold to Mrs Janine Whitehead in July, stayed here to go to the National Show, and promptly achieved the unbelievable - won the Supreme Inhand Championship!! Wow!!

This is the second of my homebred mares to achieve this title, and the fourth from this stud to achieve the title of National Champion Mare. We may be a small stud but I guess I'm doing something right!

Gloria also did really well on the Sunday too. She had only been backed three weeks before the show, but we rather rashly decided to enter her for the Low School and the Prelim Dressage. Well she came 2nd out of 5 in the Low School and 9th out of 10 in the dressage (despite doing no canter work due to the slippery grass) and behaved impeccably - so I'm very proud of her. Gloria is now living in Jersey and having a wonderful time hacking all over this lovely island before settling down to train for a career as a competition dressage horse.

Maryss Kilate, our colt that was born in Spain, has now travelled back to Continental Europe but this time he's gone to Denmark where he has taken up residence

with a Danish bred PRE colt and two warmblood geldings. His new owners are BAPSH members Jane & Tim Friis. He seems to have settled in very well and is apparently setting a very good example of how you should behave properly to his rather naughty young friend, Taranto.

Kilate's mother, Duquesa LV has now been broken in and is going really nicely under saddle. She has a free forward moving stride, and as you would expect is a quick and co-operative learner. Duquesa is now for sale as a riding mare (she has not been put infoal this year) and/or as a future breeding mare. She will also do well, I expect, in the inhand classes in the UK - she was very successfull as a youngster in Spain.

Well I wish all fellow breeders and enthusiasts a minimally wet and muddy winter, (some hope!) and lets look forward to warm Spring sunshine and new baby foals arriving into the world safely.

An adoption service is provided for orphans, the trust will take on the nursing of orphans, injured foals, problem foalers, and any problem too much for a breeder to cope with. They also have a frozen mare colostrum bank which members can access.

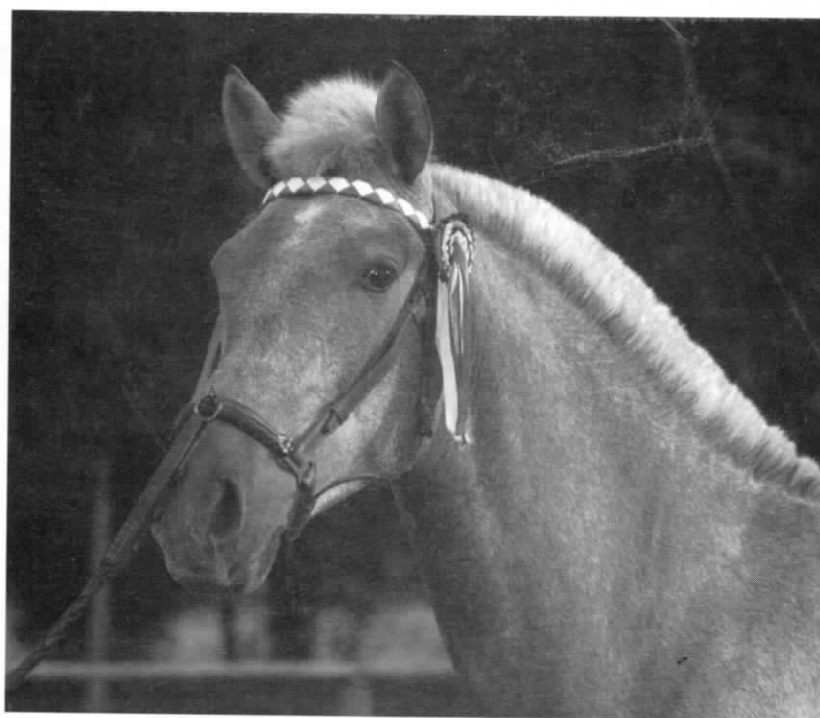
