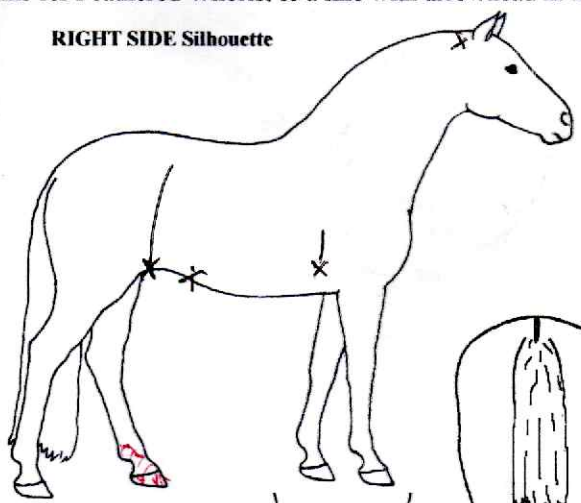
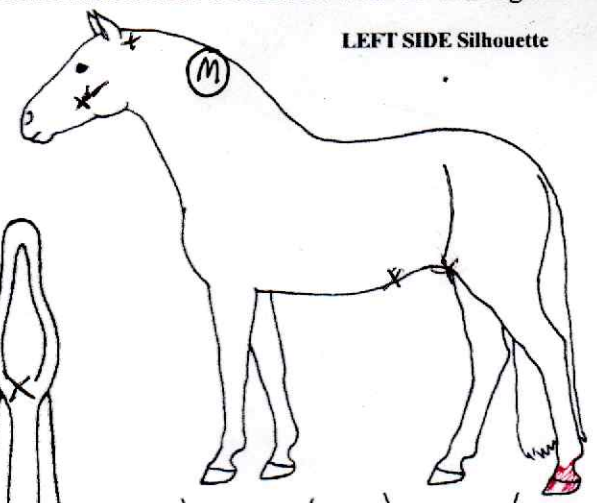

BODY Rt side Whorl behind Elbow feathered upwards. Bilateral very lowest Pectoral Whorls feathered  
up to mid Breast. Bilateral Abdominal Whorls. Bilateral lowest Flank fold Whorls feathered  
upwards.
